Recently, there has been an effort launched to enact a Special Business District (SBD) that would make it possible to address these concerns. The work of the SBD Board does not diminish the work that is being done by our city officials. We will still need volunteers and advocates to lobby the Board of Aldermen and other elected officials to insist on maintaining municipal services.

With each successful SBD that is adopted in the City, it encourages others to implement a district in their own area. It is always wonderful when we can say an effort is a win-win, and in my opinion that is certainly the case with the adoption of our SBD.
